

Supply of shelter material- GI sheets



Scope of the Project: Immediately after the end of the civil war, Government of India approved a Project to supply 10,400 Metric Tonnes of Galvanized Iron Sheets to Internally displaced people affected by the war as immediate relief for construction of temporary shelters along with cement which was sanctioned simultaneously.



Project Cost: SLR 1.3 billion (INR 50 Crore)

Project Status: Completed
(Project duration: 12 months, 2009-2010)

Modality of implementation:

The sheets were distributed to the affected families at the rate of 12 sheets per family through the Government Agents of Jaffna, Mullaitivu, Kilinochchi, Vavuniya and Mannar districts under the overall supervision of the Ministry of Economic Development

Beneficiaries: 80,000 IDP families



Impact: Under the Project, about 10,400 MT of GI sheets of approximately 1.50 million GI sheets were distributed to about 80,000 families displaced during the war which has benefitted about 3,50,000 individuals. The Project was able to assist the IDPs to cater to their immediate shelter requirements along with the cement distributed by the Indian Government.
